Applicant must:

- Have intentions of entering or have already been accepted in a medical field of study at an accredited college or trade school. **Please list school**
- Applicant must be a current resident of Baptist Health Hardin's 10-county service area. **Please** circle the county of residence:

- Provide a copy of a high school and/or college transcript if already enrolled with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Provide a written recommendation from a teacher/instructor.
- Provide a summary of why you are requesting this scholarship.
- Apply by **April 1** for consideration.

Applications will be reviewed by a committee from the Auxiliary to select the recipients. The Baptist Health Auxiliary Executive Committee will approve the selection.
